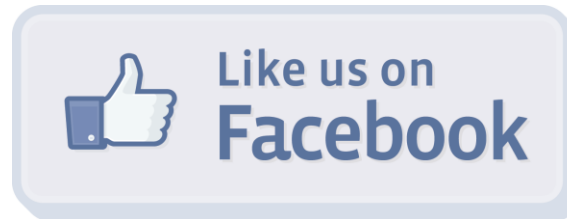

Mission Statement

The athletic department will strive to meet the demands that may arise with an expanding community.

Things to know:

Age: Participants must be four (4) years old and no more than fifteen (15) years old as of September 1. Everyone that registers by the deadline will guarantee a spot on a team.

Fee: The **fee** for Newport Parks and Recreation Basketball is \$40.00. This covers the cost of the uniform tops, facility maintenance, and other contracted services.

Practices: Practices will be held during the week and some Saturdays depending on the schedule of games for that day.

Games: Games will be played on Fridays and Saturdays in November and run through the

end of February. The league will take a break from playing games during the time that the elementary schools are out for Christmas break.

Player Evaluations: There will be player evaluations of for the 7-8 boys and girls, the 9-10 boys and girls, and the 11-12 boy's and girl's league. **The Co-Ed basketball leagues (4-6) will not have a player evaluation.** Player Evaluation dates will be on the back of this brochure. It is our goal to make every team as evenly matched as possible.
